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School Photos

The photographer will be in school on **Monday 2**nd **October** to take the children's individual photographs. They will have the photos taken in the morning. Please ensure your child comes to school in full school uniform. If they do not have a school jumper on, we will give them one to wear.

Sickness and Diarrhoea

It is that time of year when there are lots of bugs around. When a child has been sick or had diarrhoea, they must not return to school for 48 hours after the last time they were ill. This is also the case with Munchkins (after school club).

Uniform & Jewellery

All children are expected to wear school uniform or PE uniform on a PE day. We have spare uniform that you are welcome to take if you need it. We do not expect the children to have branded uniform but jumpers must be dark green.

The children should not be wearing jewellery in school. They can wear a watch and stud earrings only. If they come to school wearing rings or necklaces they will be asked to take them off and be kept in a safe place until the end of the day.

Breakfast Club Drop Off

Please can we remind parents that breakfast club opens at 8am. If children arrive before this they must be supervised by an adult until the doors open. School staff are not able to supervise children before breakfast club opens.

Holiday in Term Time

Parent Governors

We are still looking for a parent governor to join our Local Academy Council. This is an opportunity for parents to get more involved in school, find out how and why we do things and how we can continue to improve our school.

There is a time commitment of attending 6 meetings a year and reading the paperwork related to these meetings in advance. If you are able to give more time it would be lovely to have governors in school during the day, looking at how the school is run.

If this is something you are interested in, please let me know and I can talk you through the role further.

Coffee Morning

We would like to start running parent coffee mornings where parents can meet up and talk. Eventually, we would like a parent or group of parents to take on the running of these. If you are interested in this please speak to Mrs Morley on the gate.

School Day Arrangements and Timings

From Monday 2nd October we are changing how the children enter and leave at the beginning and end of the school day. We ask that parents waiting to collect children wait behind the bollards towards the carpark so that the courtyard is clear for the children to be dismissed from. An email with further details has been sent out.

The registers are taken and closed at 9am. Any child who arrives after 9am is marked as late. If they arrive after 9.10am then they receive an unauthorised absence mark. If a child receives 8 unauthorised sessions in a 10-week period they may receive a penalty notice fine. The fines start at £60 per child, per parents/carer. Fines rise if they are not paid on time. Please note, fines are issued by Bristol Local Authority not the school.

From January 2024 the school day will be extended to 3.30pm in line with government expectations of hours in the school day. The children's lunch will then become 12-1pm.

Secondary School Applications

For those children who will be starting secondary school next year you will need to apply for a place in the next few months. You apply online using the Council website. Applications open on 12 September 2023 and close on 31st October 2023.

Lots of schools are holding their open days and evening this term. We will pass these dates on to you as soon as we have them. They are also advertised on the individual school websites.

Reducing the Number of Pupil Admissions

Waycroft Multi Academy Trust and the Leadership Team of Wicklea Academy propose to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN) for Year 3 from 90 to 60, to take effect from September 2025.

The proposed change falls in line with the Infant feeder school which reduced their PAN 3 years ago and takes account of the decline in primary numbers seen across the city. The Trust and staff are working hard to improve the outcomes of all our pupils and feel strongly that the proposed reduction will benefit future outcomes for our children, whilst still enabling us to meet the demand of places.

There will be no other changes to the admission arrangements. The proposed change will not affect the current pupils or those who choose to accept an offer for a school place in September 2024. All current and future parents and any other interested stakeholders can make comments on this proposal, by either writing to the address below or email the school Office.
